To Do List

1. **REPLY:** *Reply by email to Mark Pingle pingle@unr.edu to confirm you have received this invitation and update contact information, regardless of whether you will attend the reunion. In your reply, please provide your current surface mail address and phone number. This will allow us to update our database on the Class of '78, and know which classmates are still "lost."*
2. **OFFER TO HELP:** A primary need at this point is tracking down "lost" classmates. You can help this task wherever you live, using the internet, phone, and your creativity. There may be other tasks you can help with as the reunion approaches. If you are willing to help, reply by email and we will find a way for you to help.
3. **SEND INFO YOU HAVE ON LOST CLASSMATES:** From previous sources, we have contact information for many classmates. However, we have no contact information for the classmates you will find listed below. Please look at this list and email Mark Pingle pingle@unr.edu to provide any information that will help find one of the people on the list. As the reunion approaches, we will send you an updated list of lost classmates, and ask you again for help finding those who are still lost. Hopefully, by working together, we can let everyone know about the reunion.

4. **OFFER SUGGESTIONS:** This is your reunion. You may have ideas to help make it better. After reading the information below, please email your ideas to us. For example, at this time, there are no specific activities planned for the reunion weekend, other than the Saturday evening event. However, you may have ideas for other activities. If enough people want to golf Saturday morning, for example, we can get a group rate at the golf course. If you are interested in any extra activity, we will help you organize it and let others know about it.

5. **IF YOU KNOW YOU WILL ATTEND, LET US KNOW:** Email Mark Pingle at pingle@unr.edu if you know you will attend. You are welcome to bring a guest or guests. Let Mark know the names of those who will attend. At a later date, but before the reunion is held, you will be asked to mail in a payment for the reunion.

Information on the Reunion

1. **Reunion Dinner and Evening Activities:** The theme is a Hawaiian Luau, and the menu will include tri-tip, barbecued chicken, baked beans, Hawaiian salad, and more. Feel free to dress casually, a Hawaiian shirt if you like, and be prepared to have a relaxing, fun time. While there will be a few planned activities, most of the evening will be free time, so you will have opportunity to interact and catch up with others. There will be a no-host bar open. If you have a suggestion for any planned activity that you think should be part of the reunion evening, please contact us.
2. **Pricing:** The price of the reunion is tentative because there is a fixed cost for renting the Pavilion at the golf course. If many classmates attend, then we will be able to reduce the price per person below \$50. By Spring 2008, we should have some idea of how many are planning to attend and we can fix a price.
3. **Class of 1978 Endowment Fundraiser:** As part of our 30 year reunion, we will be working with Mr. Bowles and the D-9 Foundation to establish an endowment that will support education (e.g. fund college scholarships) in the Eagle Point School District in the name of the EPHS Class of 1978. The goal is to present a check to Mr. Bowles at the reunion for at least \$20,000. This dollar amount will fund an endowment that will provide funding each year, forever (or at least as far into the future as we can imagine), to help Eagle Point students. Of course, it will be easier to reach the \$20,000 goal if a larger percentage of 1978 EPHS graduates participate by giving to the endowment. The great thing is that we have already obtained \$10,000 matching funds, so that any gifts made by our classmates will be matched until the \$20,000 goal is reached, meaning we must only raise \$10,000. Mr. Bowles, who many of you had for a vo-ag class in high school, along with others, has done a great job developing the D-9 foundation to help EP students. If we can achieve our goal, we will be the first EPHS class to establish an endowment, providing an example that other classes can follow, something that will give the D-9 foundation a big boost. Whether you play a smaller or larger part in this, we hope you will participate. It will be satisfying to work together as a class and accomplish this good deed. You will receive more information on this in the future.
